Subject: Required Compliance – Mexico's Electronic Value Manifestation

Dear Valued Supplier,

Adient is committed to ensuring full compliance with all global customs regulations. As part of this effort, we want to inform you of significant updates issued by the Mexican customs authorities regarding the Mandatory Electronic Manifestation of Value (**Manifestación de Valor Electrónica – MVE**).

Effective April 1, 2026, Mexico will assess fines for incorrect MVE submissions. Importers must upload all valuation information and supporting documents before customs clearance.

To avoid fines, your invoice must accurately match the applicable Adient Purchase Order (PO) revision, with invoice details verified against the correct PO revision number, and include:

- Exact legal entity name (not DBA)
- Address
- Tax ID
- Incoterms
- Price

Please respond promptly to any requests for clarification or additional documentation. Failure to comply with accurate invoice data will result in fines imposed by the Mexican government, which will be charged back to the supplier.
